MIAMI-DADE EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY (MDX) TO HOST PUBLIC KICKOFF MEETING Community Encouraged to Provide Input on Proposed SR 924 West Extension to the Homestead Extension of the Florida Turnpike (HEFT)

HIALEAH GARDENS, Fla., April 7, 2010– The Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) has scheduled a public kickoff meeting to allow the community to discuss the SR 924/Gratigny Parkway West Extension to the Homestead Extension of the Florida Turnpike (HEFT) project as part of the Project Development and Environment Study (PD&E). The meeting will be held on Wednesday, April 14, 2010, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Westland Gardens Park, Community Center, 13501 NW 107th Avenue in Hialeah Gardens.

The PD&E Study will evaluate alternatives for the proposed extension of the Gratigny Parkway west to the HEFT. The public kickoff meeting will give property owners, residents and interested parties an opportunity to receive information and provide input on the project during this phase of the study. Participation and input is strongly encouraged and appreciated.
